

Tips for Father Engaging Fathers During Visits

Make Dads Feel Important

- 1. Ask dad why he feels it is important to be involved in child's life.
- 2. Help dad ask the questions they need to get their point across
- 3. Treat dad the same way you treat mom. They are both parents.
- 4. During visit, ask dad questions.

Invite Dad to Join Visit

- 1. If present, try to talk to dad and get him to join visit.
- 2. If dad comes in late, wrap up slowly to invite him to next visit or to include in final questions at the visit.
- 3. If dad is in the other room ask child, "Do you want to show dad your activity?" then praise the child for bringing dad over.

Ask mom

- 1. If dad is not there, ask mom how dad is doing?
- If dad is not there, parent educator can ask to schedule a later home visit for when dad can attend.

Other Tips

- 1. Be genuine.
- 2. Thank dad for attending visit.
- 3. Invite dad to group connection
- 4. Video chat with dad if not at visit
